STUDENT CONCERNS PROCEDURE

OBJECTIVES

- 1 To ensure that a Code of Student Rights and Responsibilities is written and published.
- 2 To ensure that students know the appropriate procedures for dealing with any infringement of their rights.
- 3 To ensure that concerns are made known to the appropriate people and treated with discretion and fairness.
- 4 To ensure that any concern investigated is followed up with a response to the student.

GUIDELINES

- 1 The "open-door" policy of the Principal, senior administration staff and other staff members is maintained, as well as the practice of self-referral to the Counsellor.
- 2 The Code of Student Rights and Responsibilities is made available to all students.
- 3 A list of people designated as contact for students is drawn up annually and published for their information.
- 4 Concerns are passed on to relevant staff members, where this is appropriate, and the Principal/DP/AP are informed in writing. The student is informed that the concern is being passed on.
- 5 Concerns are investigated. There is an undertaking to report back to the student once the concern has been addressed and dealt with.
