

WITHDRAWING FROM A STANDARD PROCEDURE

Rationale

Throughout the year students, teachers and parents may request a change to the achievement and unit standards in a student's course. It is important to monitor course changes to ensure that students are given the best opportunity to achieve the relevant qualifications for their future direction.

Procedures

1. Students who wish to withdraw from any standard must firstly discuss the situation with their subject/course teacher, Whānau Teacher, Subject Teacher followed by the Head of Department.

2. Students who wish to withdraw from any standard after 1 June must have parental/caregivers' written permission. The <u>"Withdrawing from a Standard"</u> form is to be used.

3. Teachers who wish to withdraw a student from a standard after the 1 June must obtain parental/caregivers' written permission. The <u>"Withdrawing from a Standard</u>" form also to be completed.

4. Any changes to a student's course after the 1 June must be approved by the Dean and the Head of Curriculum, Mrs Potter. This is to ensure the student has enough credits including literacy and numeracy, to achieve the desired qualification.

5. The student must take the completed form to the Head of Curriculum, Mrs Potter who will discuss and clarify with the student about their continued attendance and meeting of course requirements.

6. The Head of Curriculum, Mrs Potter will make the final decision. A copy of the form will be given to the Principal's Nominee for reference, the course teacher and Head of Department.

7. The Head of Department will be responsible for removing the student from the standard in Musac Edge.

8. If a student is withdrawn from an external standard, this must be done by 25 August (SAC students the date is 1 July). *These dates may change each year.*
